

### 1 Camphor

A monoterpenoid ketone with a pungent fragrance that is as reminiscent of mothballs. It is commonly derived from *Cinnamomum camphora*, from which it lends its name. It is a constituent of turpentine and has been used by certain cultures as an embalming fluid due to its antimicrobial effects. Found in camphor laurel, rosemary, East African camphorwood, goldenasters, coriander, feverfew, tarragon, nutmeg, sweet wormwood, yerba buena, mountain mint, hyssop, forskohlii, tansy, thyme, turmeric...etc.

### 2 α-Pinene

One of two isomers of the monoterpene Pinene, the most abundant terpene in the natural world. It is responsible for the distinct aroma of many coniferous trees, particularly pines, from which it derives its name. It is a primary constituent of turpentine. Found in pines, rose gun, parsley, frankincense, guava, juniper, rosemary, nutmeg, blue gum, valerian...etc.

### 3 Eucalyptol

A monoterpenoid alcohol with a fragrance that can be described as a combination of fresh, spicy, herbal and minty. It is sometimes added to cigarettes and mouthwashes as a flavorant. Although sometimes used as an insect repellent, it is a powerful attractant to certain male bees. Found in eucalyptus, rosemary, wormwood, sage...etc.
